The Arkansas Radiological Society continued to thrive this year because of all the wonderful teamwork!

We were excited to host Jessica W. T. Leung, MD, FACR, FSBI, Professor and Deputy Chair in the Department of Breast Imaging at the University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center, as our keynote speaker for our 2023 Annual CME conference. Dr. Leung is Past President of the Society of Breast Imaging, has published extensively, and has lectured nationally and internationally. She gave three outstanding lectures which included a discussion of Breast Asymmetries, Nodal Assessment, and Neoadjuvant Therapy. In addition to Dr. Leung, we also had four of our own Arkansas Radiologists, all fellowship trained in Breast Imaging, who provided outstanding lectures. Dr. Bennett Battle gave a talk on Cryoablation of Breast Cancers, Dr. Holly Gonzales gave a talk on the Management of Atypical Breast Lesions, Dr. Rachel Pollitzer Pahls gave a talk on Automated Breast Ultrasound, and Dr. Shyann Renfroe talked on Common Skin Findings Encountered in Breast Imaging. The conference was informative and well attended by residents, fellows, and both academic and private practice radiologists from around the state.

The ACR celebrated 100 years, and all chapters were invited to make a celebratory video. Dr. Amanda Ferrell, Dr. Ken Robbins, Dr. Scott Harter, Dr. Alex Kochi, Dr. Jameson Gilstrap, and I worked with a professional videographer to produce a video from our chapter in celebration of the ACR's 100 years. Our video was highlighted as one of the best videos received by the ACR. I am incredibly proud of this team effort by our executive committee which included our residents. Our chapter video was played several days at the ACR 2023 Annual meeting in the check-in area.

Our chapter was awarded Overall Excellence for the year, and we

were presented with a certificate at the annual meeting.

We continued to participate in journal clubs with the residents in the year, and we provided mentoring opportunities for medical students.
